Château Ksara is Lebanon's oldest, largest, and most visited winery. It was here, in 1857, that Jesuit brothers laid the foundations for the country's modern winemaking industry by producing Lebanon's first non sweet red wine. Over the last decade, Château Ksara has seen the introduction of new grape varieties as well as developments in technique and the application of advanced science by French oenologists.
